Winners and Losers, Forces and Factions: Where Does SA Stand after the 2019 Election?

In the almost two months since the general election, much has happened. The balance of power in Parliament has shifted slightly away from the two biggest parties; there is a new, smaller Cabinet, lacking most of the 'Zuma loyalists' of the previous administration; but many of these have popped up as portfolio committee chairs; evidence of factionalism in the ANC, and tensions in the DA and EFF, is ever more obvious; there are signs that President Ramaphosa is having trouble asserting his authority – many were disappointed by a bland State of the Nation Address that seemed to sidestep important issues like land and the unbundling of Eskom. And in all this, we have to rely for our information on a political media that sometimes reports superficially and appears to be more interested in sensation than substance.
